

## Garden Report: July 2, 2016

It was a three cart day at the garden today. We had a good crew with a bunch of regulars and a couple first timers.



The small cart was filled just with cabbages - and they were huge - we harvested a couple 5 and 6 pound cabbages today. And we started harvesting our second crop of bok choy today - delivering 24 pounds of bok choy to the pantry.

We continue to set new records for harvest this year - with 68 pounds of produce going to the pantry this morning. That makes our total for the year 244 pounds of produce. We delivered 23 varieties of produce this morning, including arugula, basil, beans, broccoli, carrots, cauliflower, dill, kale, leeks, lettuce, mint, peas, parslane, parsley, peppers, radishes, sage, swiss chard, tarragon and thyme. Yum. Doesn't it look great?
